

ORDINANCE NO. 429

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA; CERTIFYING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010-11 ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA; CONTAINING A REPEALER PROVISION; A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 200.065 provides the City of Orange City shall adopt a millage rate to provide ad valorem tax revenue for governmental purposes for the 2010-11 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has delivered her recommended budget for said year in accordance with Article VII, Section 7.01 of the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that to provide adequate services to the citizens of Orange City the millage rate for the fiscal year 2010-11 shall be set at 6.3445 mills which is below the rolled-back rate as provided by the Property Appraiser of Volusia County and does not reflect an increase in ad valorem taxes and;

WHEREAS, the first public hearing on the millage rate has been conducted by the City Council at 7:00 P.M. on September 15, 2010 and the final public hearing will be conducted on September 28, 2010, at 7:00 P.M. in the City Council Chambers at 201 N. Holly Ave., Orange City, Florida.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA.

SECTION 1. That the certified millage rate shall be 6.3445 mills, for the purpose of realizing a sum sufficient to meet and defray the necessary ordinary running and operating expenses of the City of Orange City, Florida, for the year beginning October 1, 2010, and ending September 30, 2011.

SECTION 2. The final millage rate of 6.3445 reflects a decrease of 3.12% below the rolled-back rate as certified by Property Appraiser of Volusia County and is below maximum millage rate for the City of Orange City and requires a simple majority vote for the 2010-11 fiscal year (Per s. 200.065(5)(a), F.S.).

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director shall notify the Department of Revenue, the Volusia County Property Appraiser, and the Volusia County Tax Collector of the millage rate.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. If any section, part of a section, paragraph, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is declared invalid; the remaining provisions of the Ordinance shall not be effected.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.




