

RESOLUTION NO. 593-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE LOCATION OF A SUNRAIL STATION WITHIN THE PLANNING BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY; REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Orange City continues its support of a commuter rail project and resolves that the "SunRail" will contribute significantly to the economic vitality, quality of life and positive community reputation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange City seeks to connect the natural and historic resources of Orange City and West Volusia County such as bike trails, Blue Spring, historic Orange City, as well as Orange City's shopping and retail areas.

WHEREAS, the City of Orange City enjoys broad based community and business support for the location of a SunRail station within its planning boundary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orange City strongly desires to utilize the SunRail station to serve as a catalyst for creating a sustainable economic base through revitalization of the 17-92 corridor and connecting our medical and health care industry to the region; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Orange City has the community and business support, available land for transit-oriented development, and road infrastructure, all necessary to become a viable partner in the commuter rail project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE CITY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Orange City does hereby support and request the placement of a SunRail station within the planning boundary of the City of Orange City.

SECTION 2. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Orange City, Florida.
